



Note the carved Indian head and tepee on the stone. Tradition says that Henriette, wife of Alexis, was of Native American/Indian heritage but no definite confimation has been made.

This wooden marker is no longer in existence. It had been carved by a family member and was possibly erected on what is/was the Langley land on the St. John River, St. Francis, Madawaska Co, New Brunswick, Canada. The Langley's had been cultivating their land but tradition goes that a section of that tilled land had been the small cemetery of the Oakes family. It was agreed that the Langley's would no longer cultivate the supposed burial site and the marker was erected there but years took its toll on the wooden headstone. (The above was told to Leslie Poole by Darrell McBreairty of Allagash, ME in Nov 2013)

An email to Leslie Poole from Brandy Plourde notes that the following information came from Allen Jackson: the burial spot of the Oakes family is called the 'Reclaimed Cemetery'. Around 1982, the Provincial Government of New Brunswick granted an application to have the spot brought back to a cemetery. It is/was along the St. John River, in what Brandy believes is Connors, NB. It had been a potato field for years.
